Grace is so much more.. ..think of the hymn "Amazing grace, how sweet the sound that saved a wretch like me." This hymn was written by John Newton, a onetime slave ship owner who became an abolitionist for the slave trade, a committed Christian and a priest. John Newton recognised God's saving grace in his life that transformed him to become the person God wanted him to be.

There is a saying that goes something like "Grace is not getting the punishment we do deserve and receiving blessings which we don't deserve."
