- The Judges' decision is final. If any competitor, or anyone connected to a competitor is abusive to a judge, they will be asked to leave the show field and any further entries will not be refunded.
- Any objection must be made within 30 minutes of the class ending and must be accompanied by £20.00, which will be refunded if objection is upheld.
- The organisers accept no responsibility for loss, damage or injury to persons, animals, vehicles or property.
- Every effort has been made when planning this schedule to avoid clashes. The Stewards will be sympathetic but we cannot delay classes unduly or refund entries missed.
